Sheltering Arms Operation StoryBook T-Shirt Art Contest Rules



Eligibility: Only currently enrolled Sheltering Arms children and Sheltering Arms alumni are eligible for this contest.

Deadline: Artwork must be submitted no later than **Friday, July 30 at 5 PM.**

Voting: Three finalists will be chosen and posted on the web for voting by the general public, beginning Monday, August 2. The winner will be chosen based on the web vote and will be announced August 14.

How to Submit: Submit artwork to your local Sheltering Arms center director, or email a high resolution JPEG to pkubik@shelteringarmsforkids.com. You may also mail or deliver your art to Paige McKay Kubik, Sheltering Arms Administrative Office, 385 Centennial Olympic Park Drive, Atlanta, GA 30313. All artwork must be received by Friday, July 23 at 5 PM to be eligible for the competition.

Art Specifications:

- The theme for your artwork is tigers and/or jungle life. Only original artwork done by a Sheltering Arms child or alumni will be accepted. Parents and teachers can provide materials and guidance, but the art should be the work of the child.
- Use quality art paper, construction paper, or cardstock, at least 8"x10"
- Use landscape orientation
- No 3-D artwork will be accepted
- Paints, markers, crayon, or flat collages are acceptable. No color pencils.
- We are looking for art with bright colors and bold lines that fills up the paper. Artwork on white paper will be framed with a bright mat. Please see the children's art on this flyer for examples.
- Scanned art may be submitted to pkubik@shelteringarmsforkids.com. Only high resolution JPEGs (at least 300 dpi) will be accepted. If you are selected as the winner, we will need access to the original artwork.
- Please note child's name, age, and contact information on the back of the artwork.

Prize Winner: The winner's artwork will be featured on the official 2010 Sheltering Arms Operation StoryBook T-Shirt and on other Operation StoryBook promotional materials. Each member of the winner's immediate family will receive a t-shirt and a free pass to the Operation StoryBook CockTales & Legends Reception on September 16. The winner's legal guardian will be required to sign a release form giving permission for use of his/her child's artwork in Sheltering Arms' print and online promotions.
